Wednesday Devotional

Importance of Prayer

All Christians have the privilege of going to God in prayer. Prayer for self, others, the church, church leaders, and government leaders. God wants us to humble ourselves before Him and depend on Him for our needs.

Let’s review these scriptures (NIV):

1. Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thess. 5:16-18
2. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7
3. This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. 1 John 5:14
4. Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. Colossians 4:2
5. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. Mark 11:24
6. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. Jer. 29:12
7. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Romans 12:12
8. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. James 5:16
