GOD USES PEOPLE

The more I study the Bible, the more I have to study the Bible! You know my saying, "God uses people who do not want to do His will to do His will and never violates their will in the process." But God also uses people who want to do His will.

The story of Moses is one such illustration. "By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw he was a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's edict" (Hebrews 11:23). What did his parents know? And how did they know it? Remember that "Faith comes by hearing". Without revelation there can be no faith! So we must surmise that God communicated with the parents of Moses. So the mother of Moses placed him in a basket and put him in the water so that when "The daughter of Pharaoh came down to bathe at the Nile, with her maidens walking alongside the Nile; and she saw the basket among the reeds and sent her maid, and she brought it to her" (Exodus 2:5). "So Pharaoh's daughter took him away and nurtured him as her own son. Moses was educated in all the learning of the Egyptians, and he was a man of power in words and deeds" (Acts 7:21-22). And Stephen tells us that when Moses defended one of his Jewish brethren by killing an Egyptian that "he supposed that his brethren understood that God was granting them deliverance through him, but they did not understand" (Acts 7:25). So Moses had to run away to save his life.

"By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward" (Hebrews 11:24-26). God used Moses to accomplish his purpose. And Moses was willing to be used. Are you?

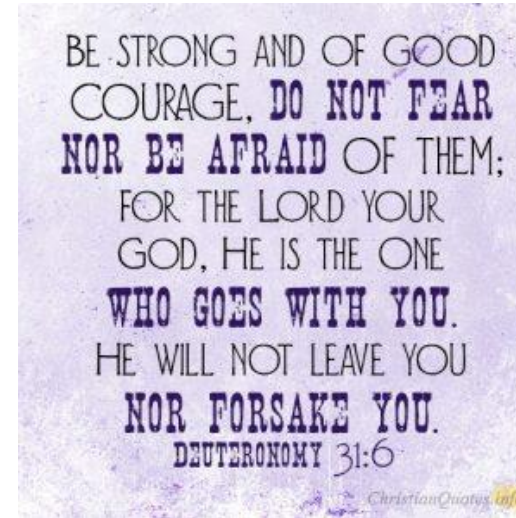
