OBEY YOUR LEADERS

You may have heard the account of the man who walked up to the store on the side of the hill

and asked if they had seen a group of people walking by. He said, "I need to catch up with them, I'm their leader." This is a negative illustration which shows the opposite of what a leader should be. The leader should be one who is out in front leading, not being behind trying to catch up. Someone has said, "You cannot lead where you will not go; you cannot teach what you do not know." The Hebrew writer speaks about this subject in chapter 13:7, "Remember those who led you, who spoke the word of God to you; and considering the result of their conduct, imitate their faith." And 13:17, "Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you." Spiritual leaders are to be teachers both by imparting knowledge and showing how to apply that knowledge. Verse 7 speaks to both of these things. And verse 17 calls for obedience to those leaders. And it is an interesting word, this word obey. The Greek word is $\pi \in (\theta \in \theta)$ present passive imperative of $\pi \in (\theta)$. It means "to persuade, to have confidence, to assure." The passive voice carries the idea of action upon the subject. And I don't have to tell you what imperative means. So to obey means to be persuaded. This is a powerful statement. When leaders set the example of the teaching which they impart, it is easy to listen to them. But the important thing is for the follower, the listener, the student to desire to know God, to follow God's word. The one who is to be persuaded must be looking for the truth. Then when it is presented to them, they find it easy to be persuaded by their leaders. For you see the ultimate teaching, example, authority is God. Jesus is the supreme example of this. He said, "If anyone is willing to do His will, he will know of the teaching, whether it is of God or whether I speak from Myself." The same should be true of our leaders and of us.
