RESPONSIBILITY TO GOD!

“Daniel Webster, who was born in New Hampshire in 1782, became one of the most eloquent orators ever to grace the American scene. On one occasion, Mr. Webster was asked to state the most important thought that ever occurred to his mind. His reply was simple and pointed. ‘The most important thought I ever had,’ he said, “was that of my individual responsibility to God.” What does it mean “to have responsibility” to God. We understand that words get their meaning from sentences. And we know that sentences get their meanings from paragraphs and contexts. There is always the immediate context and there is the greater context. The greater context of who God is, is the Bible! We get the true definition of who God is from all that the Bible reveals about God. Our responsibility is to God. If the God that we know is not the God of the Bible, it is the wrong God.

The responsibility we have to God is to believe in Him. To believe in God in the truest sense of the word is to trust Him. It is not enough to just believe that there is a God, we must believe that He is the God, the only God, the true and living God. I wish I had the ability to say things the way they need to be said, but I do not so these will have to do. The God of the Bible and our relationship to Him in and as life is summed up in Jesus Christ. “For God so loved the world that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.” (John 3:16-18).

Our responsibility is not because we are accountable to God and we need to fear judgment! Those who do not believe in God through Jesus are judged already. Our responsibility is to trust Him! And that is with our life!
