WALKING WITH GOD!

In all the Bible and among all the characters of the Bible only two were said to have walked with God.

“Enoch lived sixty- five years and became the father of Methuselah. Then Enoch walked with God three hundred years after he became the father of Methuselah, and he had other sons and daughters. So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty- five years. Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him” (Genesis 5:21-24).

“Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his time; Noah walked with God” (Genesis 6:9).

The prophet wrote to Judah during the days of “Jotham, Ahaz and Hezekiah, kings of Judah” saying, “He has told you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?” (Micah 6:8).

We sing the song, “I come to the garden alone while the dew is still on the roses.... And He walks with me and He talks with me. And He tells me I am His own.” One comedienne said, “When we say we talk to God it is called prayer. When we say God talks with us we are called schizophrenic.”

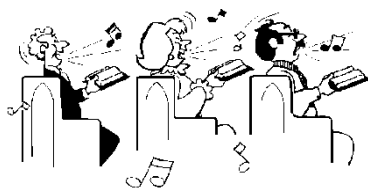

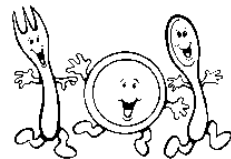


Thank You!
