WHAT’S THE BIG IDEA?

A statement by Dallas Willard in his book *Hearing God* struck me right where I live and I believe where you live. “There is no avoiding the fact that we live at the mercy of our ideas. This is never more true than with our ideas about God. Meaning well is not enough. Those who operate on the wrong information are likely never to know the reality of God’s presence in the decisions which shape their lives and will miss the constant divine companionship for which their souls were made.” (*Hearing God*, p. 10).

Our ideas about God shape our thinking about God. Our conclusions about how He thinks, how He acts, how He talks. It shapes the way we receive what He says and does. The Bible is God’s revelation of Himself to us. He reveals the way He thinks by what He says and does. He calls us to action based upon Himself and His actions the foundation of which is who He is. The place from which we get the truth about God is in that revelation. Only God could have given us the Bible.

But the Bible is not the only place where we get information about God. And if the information we get is not consistent with that which He gives us, we receive the wrong information. When our ideas about God and what He wants us to do is based on incorrect information we come to the wrong conclusions. If we act on these wrong conclusions then our lives are misshaped. And we find ourselves in all kinds of problems.

When I look at my life, I find that I am in all kinds of problems. They are problems that I have created by the choices that I make based on my idea of what is happening. They are problems because I live among people who make choices based on their ideas. The more my ideas are based on truth the better decisions I can and should make.
