"Paul, a bond-servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the faith of those chosen of God and the knowledge of the truth which is according to godliness, in the hope of eternal life, which God, who cannot lie, promised long ages ago,.... "...for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus" Romans 3:26). Our God, our Holy God, our Loving God, our sovereign God cannot want to do things that are in opposition to His very nature. God only wants to do what is loving and holy.
