## GOD IS HOLY! HOLY! HOLY!

When Richard Rogers wrote his little book on The Book of Revelation, he entitled it “Hallelujah Anyway”! The gist of the theme is that regardless of what it looks like, of the way things seem, the victory belongs to the saints and that because of God, and not because we won the victory. This is a fulfillment of Daniel’s prophecy, “Then the sovereignty, the dominion and the greatness of all the kingdoms under the whole heaven will be given to the people of the saints of the Highest One; His kingdom will be an everlasting kingdom, and all the dominions will serve and obey Him” (Daniel 7:28). God has given the kingdom to the saints! It is grace.

“And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say, ‘Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty, who was and who is and who is to come’” (Revelation 4:8).

We talk about the Holiness of God as though our response to Him is what shows Him to be Holy, what makes Him Holy. It is not our response to God that makes Him Holy! He has always been, is, and always will be Holy. He has not changed. And His Holiness is ruled by His love (I know I’m not saying it right). Jim McGuiggan said, “A ‘love’ that isn’t holy can’t be trusted, and a ‘love’ that finds no offense in corruption corruption and cruelty isn’t holy. A “love” that yawns at my sin will yawn at the sin of others, will yawn at the sin of a planet, will yawn at the sin of a universe. A god who loves like that is no god worthy of worship. A god like that is not a righteous god; he is morally contemptible” (The God of The Towel). I read that and I am in awe of God. But here is the quote that really God to my mind and heart, “The Cross of Christ is the one place in time and space where we see beyond all dispute that holy love can be trusted. In the life and death of Jesus Christ, the holiness of God is brought home to us, a holiness so holy that God must justify himself—in the eyes of sinners, no less—for extending forgiveness.”

God justifies Himself to sinners. Wow! When we understand that God is both “just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.” That’s where God’s Holiness is seen. Do you see it?
