DO ALL IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!

“Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father” (Colossians 3:17).

This is a follow-up from last weeks’ article. What does it mean “do all in the name of the Lord Jesus”? As you have heard me say over and over, we really need to understand how the word “name” is used in the Bible. The word “name” has to do with the character and nature of the one of which we are speaking. Remember Isaiah 9:6, “For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.” This is only one, but a great one, of the verses that speak about the name of the LORD Jesus. When Jesus acts and speaks, He speaks from His very nature. He speaks from who He is.

But please go back and begin at the beginning of chapter three and see the exhortation. There is the encouragement to “set your affections on things about where Christ is”. He tells them to consider the putting away of the sinful things. And this is the thing to which I want us to put our minds and hearts. “But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth” (Colossians 3:8). If the words which come out of you mouth at any time are described as having these characteristics, you are not doing all things in the name of the LORD! If the deeds which you perform are done from any of these motives, then you are definitely not doing “all things in the name of the LORD.

The confession that we made “with our mouth” (Romans 10:9) when we obeyed the gospel and as we live out that confession, is that “Jesus is LORD”. So the practice of our lives in both “word” and “deed” should all be done “in the name of the LORD Jesus”. His name is His authority. And we bow to that because He is at the right hand of God in heaven.
