SALVATION IS IN THE NAME OF CHRIST

“And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved” (Acts 4:12). There is no doubt that the name of which Peter speaks in this verse is “...the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead...” (Acts 4:10). The context is that of Peter and John healing the lame man at the Temple beginning in Acts 3. They then because of the commotion caused by this great event were arrested and charged not to preach any longer in this name, “And when they had summoned them, they commanded them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus” (Acts 4:19). When Peter and John persisted in continuing to preach the message about Jesus, they captured them again and “When they had brought them, they stood them before the Council. The high priest questioned them, saying, “We gave you strict orders not to continue teaching in this name, and yet, you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and intend to bring this man’s blood upon us.” But Peter and the apostles answered, “We must obey God rather than men...” (Acts 5:27-29).

Our world has dramatically changed from that of the New Testament times. And it has changed immensely from the times of the Reformation Movement when men were trying to reform the Catholic church. This is the time of history when many of the groups we call denominations. Not only our society has truly changed from the times of the Restoration Movement. And finally, it has changed from a society in which the majority of our citizens were church goers.

But the gospel message has not changed. There is still now, and will be until time ends, a need to truly know that “there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.” And we have to find a way to communicate that message to as many people as we can. We must learn to truly help people know that the Bible is the only revelation of God from which the message can be known. But because of our Post-Modern world it is getting harder and harder.

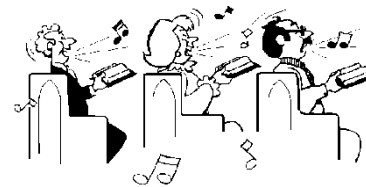
