As a result, that which constitutes religious faith often has been moulded to fit the desires of the individual.

If there were no criterion for belief, there would be adequate excuse for this kind of muddled thinking. Fortunately, we dare not be so careless. God, who made all and controls all, has provided a framework that is quite clear. God’s book tells us that man has fallen away from God and needs to find him again. The vary fact that we strive so consistently to justify ourselves is adequate proof to our inner, honest selves that we require help. Then the grace of God is shown to us in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ our Lord and savior. Through Him only can we come back to God.

Again, the way of return is quite clear. Paul tells us there is no condemnation to those that are in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1) and walk not according to the flesh, but according to the spirit (Romans 8:4).

What are we looking for in our religious faith? There can be only one goal, and that is SALVATION. Then this salvation must be worked out in the power of God for the purpose of doing his good pleasure. God’s pleasure thus becomes our pleasure, and our search for selfish satisfaction disappears.
