- (6) PROPER ATTITUDE TOWARD TIME-** Rejoice in the day the Lord has given. Pray that God's will be done, determine not to misuse or abuse the moments given, and redeem as much time as possible for the Lord, and remember, we only receive one moment at a time, a tiny little minute, but eternity is in it.
