## Looking Into the Word

(James 1:23-25)

**To illustrate what it means to hear but not heed God’s Word, James described an individual who observes his face in a mirror but fails to make changes necessary to improve his appearance (1:23-24). According to Kurt A. Richardson, “Ancient literature is replete with references to the mirror and its use as a metaphor for moral development”. Given this fact, James’ point would have been quite powerful to a first-century audience. Like the individual who looks at a mirror (i.e., a polished piece of metal) and realizes that changes need to be made but does nothing about his appearance, the individual who looks at God’s Word but fails to change his behavior acts inappropriately. This is significant, for as Jim Samra noted, “The Bible doesn’t just show us who we are; it shoes us who we are supposed to be”. Consequently, we must not only know where we fall short but also address those issues in our lives.**

**Having pointed out the error of hearing but failing to heed God’s Word, James turned his attention to the individual who both hears and obeys. Describing this individual, he wrote, “But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does” (1:25). Unlike the individual who fails to change his life when Scripture prescribes such, the one who alters his life according to God’s instructions will be blessed.**
