**Burden Bearing**

(Galatians 6:1-3)

**R**ather than acting in a divisive or unconcerned manner, Christians should seek to encourage and help one another. Although help should be given to those who are in physical need (Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 5:16; 1 John 3:17), Paul began the section by emphasizing the necessity of helping those who struggle spiritually. He declared, “Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted” (Galatians 6:1). His words are challenging for several reasons.

First, they challenge us to know our brethren and be aware when they yield to temptation (cf. 1 John 5:16). Otherwise, we could not presume to reach out to them with assistance.

#### WORSHIP SERVICES

Following Governor Abbott's order for re-opening Texas the worship service in person is at a limited capacity. we will have worship services at the building and Facebook live/online service.

If you are over the age of 65, or in a high-risk group, we encourage you to participate in our online services.

We ask that you follow the guidelines below while worshipping at the building:

**- All attendees over the age of 10 will need to wear a face mask.**

- The only exceptions for wearing the face mask will be when partaking of the Lord's Supper and men that are publicly speaking while leading in our worship service.

- Enter and exit the building through the front door. This will help to minimize the touching of common items.

- For communion, we will have disposable cups.

They will be available as you enter the building.

- Sit in alternate rows. Half of the auditorium rows will be closed.

- Individuals may sit with members of their household but must maintain 6 feet between members of different households.

**- There will no bible classes, evening worship, Tuesday lady's bible class or Wednesday night services at this time.**

- Please maintain social distancing while fellowshiping with other members. We look forward to seeing each of you this Sunday. Please continue to pray that we all may come together soon with all of the saints here at 249 Church of Christ.

Second, they challenge us to know what is acceptable to God and, conversely, what is unacceptable (cf. Ephesians 5:17). It is better to serve one another as we are to be like Christ, and Christ came to serve not to be served. Luke 22:24-30

Third, they challenge us to make sure we are living properly before we approach those who are not (cf. Matthew 7:5; 2 Corinthians 7:1).

And finally, Paul's words challenge us to reach out to our fallen brethren in an appropriate manner (cf. Proverbs 15:1-2) Importantly, when we show concern for our brethren, as Paul instructed, we help others carry their burden (Galatians 6:2) Douglas J Moo explained, "Bringing back into the fellowship of Christ a brother or sister who has strayed will often mean entering into their lives with empathy and concern to take on ourselves whatever of their own sorrows and difficulties that we can" (Galatians, 376). By doing so, we "fulfill the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2)
