Andrea Rucker has not been feeling well and has many health issues happening at once.

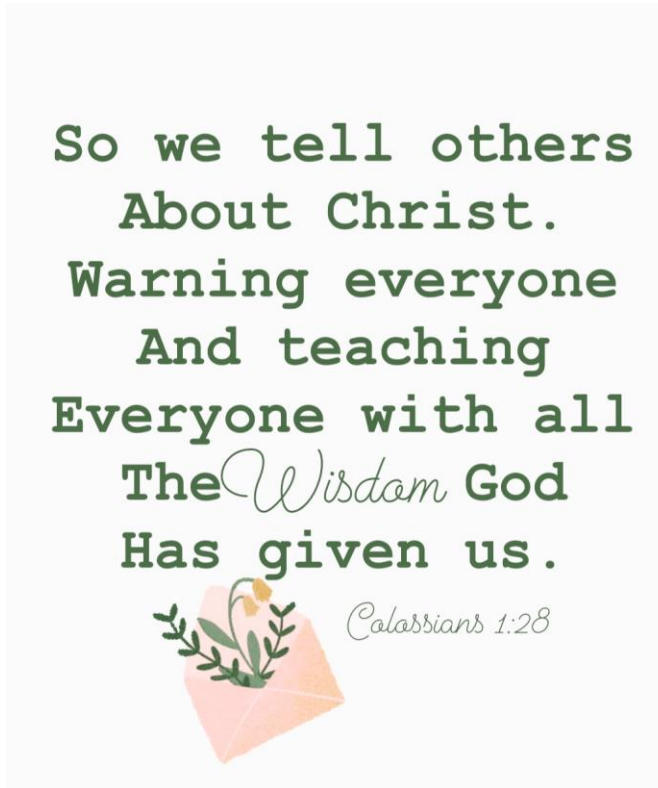
Jackie Thomas recently out of the hospital and is not feeling well and in a tremendous amount of pain.
