In Ephesians 4:1 Paul writes,  
“I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called.”

With that in mind, consider what we mean by having a “hobby”. A hobby is enjoyable. We tend to put our money into our hobby.

We spend as much extra time as possible in our hobby.

But also notice, a hobby is never first in our lives. We only put money that we can spare into it.

We only put time we can spare into it. It can never be first. So, if you let other things of this world, ball games, family, vacations, etc.

come before the work and worship of the Lord, then your religion is a hobby. Expect a surprise in judgment!
