Friends, does that remind you of anything?? I think that's exactly what sin wants us to do. It wants us to cover up sin with even more sin, and after that, it wants us to continue to cover it up with more sin. That is exactly what sin does.

See if that's not exactly how James described the enticement of sin: “Let no one say when he is tempted, ‘I am being tempted by God’; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone. But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust. Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death. Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren” (James 1:13-15). Now think of the illustration above.

The temptation (the cake) was there. Each time she walked by, the temptation grew stronger and stronger. Finally, temptation won and she began to do what she should not do. In order to cover up her mistake, she became even more deceitful.

If we are not careful, we will cover up our sins with more sin and deception. And though we may get away with it while we're here, we need to be careful, because, “our sins will find us out” (Numbers 32:23).

Sin will chew us up and spit us out when it's done with us, and too often, it doesn't get finished with us until we are hopelessly lost. Friends, let's not let that be any of us, because God has given us a great Savior who has overcome sin; His Son, Jesus Christ (1 John 4:4).
