Gayle Ringenberg (Shannon's mom) her **Aunt Patsy** is also in hospice care.

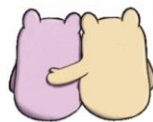
Doris Dromgoole CT scan shows inflammation in lungs will treat with steroids for now.
