The Psalmists knew of fear and Boogie Men quite well. All throughout the book, they poured their hearts out to God when darkness crowded their hearts. Long before VeggieTales, they understood that God was greater than any enemy, real or imaginary, they might face. Consider these excerpts from Psalm 27.

1 - The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?

The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

5 - For he will hide me in his shelter in the day of trouble; he will conceal me under the cover of his tent; he will lift me high upon a rock.

7 - Hear, O LORD, when I cry aloud; be gracious to me and answer me!

8 - You have said, "Seek my face." My heart says to you, "Your face, LORD, do I seek."

14 - Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; Wait for the LORD!

Do you have a Boogie Man? Is there something hiding in the closet of your heart that, from time to time, creates a moment of panic or fear for you or someone you love? That is okay. We all have them. The difference between us and the rest of the world is that we do not have to be paralyzed by our fears. We can face them, and we can hand them over to the Lord. We can do this because regardless of what yours may be, the tomato and cucumber are still right... **God IS bigger than the Boogie Man.**
