Morgan McNabb (Doris & Dixie's niece) is recovering from a sever tooth infection.

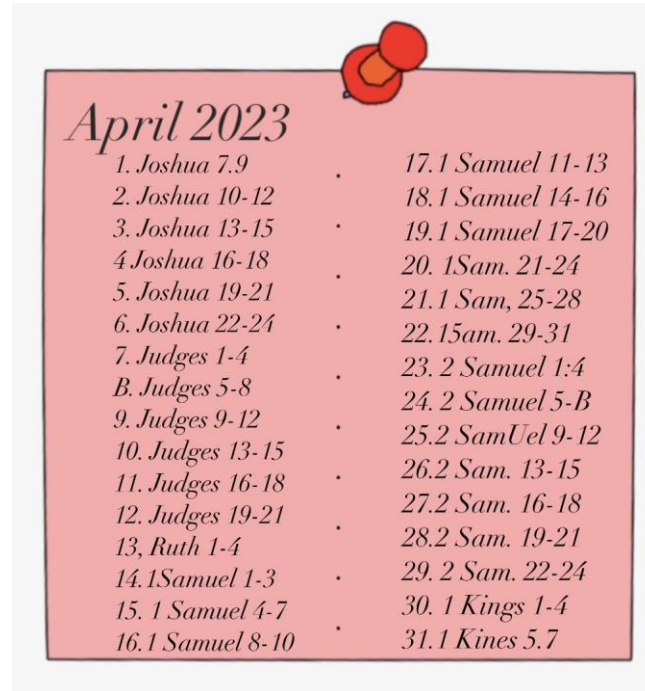
Debbie Hollander is suffering with an infection will have further testing and treatment.
