Now of course this is a song meant to teach children to be careful of what they consume (what they see, hear, say, do, go, trust, and think), but as children of God are we being careful about those things?

1.) be careful what you see

The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are healthy, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eyes are unhealthy, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!
(Matthew 6:22-23)

2.) be careful what you hear

Then He said to them, "Take heed what you hear. With the same measure you use, it will be measured to you; and to you who hear, more will be given. (Mark 4:24)

3.) be careful what say

He who guards his mouth preserves his life, *But* he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction. (Proverbs 13:3)

4.) Be careful what you do

And in all that I have said to you, be circumspect and make no mention of the name of other gods, nor let it be heard from your mouth. (Exodus 23:13)

5.) be careful where you go

You shall set bounds for the people all around, saying, 'Take heed to yourselves *that* you do *not* go up to the mountain or touch its base. Whoever touches the mountain shall surely be put to death. (Exodus 19:12)

6.) be careful whom you trust

Do not trust in a friend; Do not put your confidence in a companion; Guard the doors of your mouth from her who lies in your bosom. (Micah 7:5)

7.) be careful what you think

Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it *spring* the issues of life. Put away from you a deceitful mouth, and put perverse lips far from you. Let your eyes look straight ahead, and your eyelids look right before you. Ponder the path of your feet, and let all your ways be established. Do not turn to the right or the left; Remove your foot from evil. (Proverbs 4:23-27)

We must be careful of what we are consuming and what we are filling our heads and hearts with. It is up to YOU to be careful and mindful of what you watch, listen to, who you talk to, where you go, and what you believe. Remember: TO BE CAREFUL!!!
