The Second Continental Congress voted to approve a resolution of independence, which had been proposed in June, by Richard Henry Lee of Virginia, declaring the United States independent from Great Britain's rule. Some historians have long disputed whether members of Congress signed the Declaration of Independence on July 4, even though Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, and Benjamin Franklin, all later wrote that they had signed it on that day.

Over the years many Americans had to fight in order to keep our FREEDOM. Why is FREEDOM so important? Well, if we look at other countries without FREEDOM, we see how difficult their citizens have it. Other governments can control what the people can and cannot do, what they are allowed to possess, and even down to how many how many children they are allowed to have. These countries control their people, and their FREEDOMS. Their leaders also control their beliefs and which god they are to worship.
