Job’s Accuser

(Job 1:6 – 2:1)

These two scriptures tell us about the Devil entering in an assembly of the sons of God who gathered in the presence of God. There some more modern translations that render “angels” for “sons of God”, which have apparently influenced some to think that Satan entered heaven, to make his charges against Job. It is this writer’s conviction that Satan, after having been cast out of heaven, has never and will never enter heaven again, but has and will continue to meet where the sons of God are gathered. Did not Jesus in his parable of the Sower point out that when the word was sown, the Devil was present to take it away? Also, do we not, when we come together in our prayers, mention of coming into the presence of God?

Satan always makes it a point to be in the presence of the righteous. This is his battleground, and he desires to inflict as much damage as possible. To accomplish his mission, he seeks to deceive, depress, discourage, insult or use whatever means he deems effective to destroy souls.

Satan attempts to put worshippers into a disinterested trance. Often, he can redirect one’s thoughts from spiritual to carnal. He can influence worshippers to go through the motions without the slightest feeling of emotions.

Satan will look for the “hearers only” and encourage them to find fault, criticize, and condemn, and while working the pews will suggest to those who are weak that they need not concern themselves with being regular attenders. His purpose is to make one as lukewarm as possible and keep such a one from ever drawing closer to God.

So never think that Satan misses a single service. So long as there are those who gather in His presence, He will be present. He is the great discourager of the faithful and you or I might be the one he singles out to accuse.

After all, “Satan” can and sometimes is translated “Accuser.”

How to develop a “Positive Christian Attitude”

We are either the masters or victims of our attitudes. It is a matter of personal choice. Your attitude will make or break you, heal or hurt you, bring happiness or misery, success or failure. Here’s how you can change your attitude.

No matter what happens, look for good and you will find it.

Read Matt. 7:1 – 5. A positive thinker does not refuse to recognize the negative, he just doesn’t dwell on it.

Be an ambassador of good words to every person you meet.

Read Prov. 25:11. Be like the man who greeted every day with the words, “This is exactly the kind of day I wanted.

By an act of will, fill your mind with what is positive.

Read Phil. 4:8. Keep your mind on things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, good, virtue and that of praise.

Never surrender to negative emotion.

Read Eph. 4:31. A good way to fight weeds is to plant thick, healthy grass.

Practice the principle of replacement.

Read Rom. 12:21. Replace anger with love and fear with faith.

Bar the suggestive and immoral from your mind.

Read Rom. 12:2. Keep your mind clean by fellowship with God.

See the good in others.

Read Jhon. 1:47. Practice the “as if” principle. If you wish to possess a qualification or emotion, act as if you already have it.

Determined to have an attitude of love and goodwill toward others.

Read Phil. 2:1-4. Change your attitude toward people and their attitude will change toward you.

Express appreciation and warm feelings to others.

Read Phil. 1:19-20. One of the most healing therapies in the world is to give oneself in friendship and service to another person.

Practice positive prayer.

Read Mark. 11:25. Pray believing.
