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Hidden Treasure

"You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in heaven." (Matthew 5:14-16).

A few years ago, officials in St. Cloud, FL, found a pickle jar full of old coins in the walls of a bungalow which was in the process of being torn down. About 2000 coins dating from 1917 were found, believed to be hidden by someone during the Great Depression. The house was sold because the homeowner failed to pay code-endorsement penalties. In fact, the previous owner had lived there for months with no water or electricity. 861 half dollars, 1,016 quarters, 202 dimes, and three nickels were in the jar. The value of the coins as collector items were to be determined. However, the weight alone meant the silver was worth nearly \$10,000. The hidden treasure, unused, was of no help.
